

SOVAL ESTATE - 2019 FISHING AND SHOOTING SEASON

Charges for the 2019 Fishing season are based on a minimum of six rods up to August 10th and, thereafter, 8 rods or guns. Letting will be for periods of a week or a fortnight.

April 27 – June 29 TROUT FISHING:

£695 per person per week for 6 rods or £670 for parties of 7 rods or £640 for 8 or more rods. Inclusive of fishing, full board and lodging and services of a ghillie.

SALMON FISHING AND STALKING:

June 29 – July 6 £770 per person per week for 6 rods or £740 for parties of 7 rods or £710 for 8 or more rods; inclusive of fishing, full board and lodging and services of two ghillies and the Keeper.

July 6 – July 13 £895 per person per week for 6 rods inclusive of fishing, full board and lodging and services of two ghillies and the Keeper.

July 13– Aug 10 £995 per person per week for 6 rods inclusive of fishing, full board and lodging and services of two ghillies and the Keeper.

Aug 10 – Oct 12 £1225 per person per week for fishing and/or grouse shooting for 8 rods/guns inclusive of full board and lodging and services of two ghillies and the Keeper. There will be a charge of £1450 per week per party for those wishing to shoot. The grouse shooting is limited to a maximum bag per week. In an ordinary season, this will be 12 brace of grouse. Guests may keep the first 10 brace of grouse shot.

Oct 12–Nov 2 £1040 per person per week for fishing and/or grouse shooting for 8 rods/guns inclusive of 4 hinds, after the 20 October, full board and lodging and services of two ghillies and the Keeper. Grouse shooting charge as above. Fishing available on the whole of the Laxay system until 31 October. Loch Langavat closes on 15 October.

NOV – MAY Available for weekly lets either with full board or on self-catering basis at £3,000 per week for the Lodge, to which it may be possible to add some sport. Please enquire for availability and prices.

STALKING: Stags are available from 1st July – 20th Oct at £375 each. Hinds are also available from 21st Oct to 15th Feb at £80 each.

DRIVEN WOODCOCK:

Shooting for 6 guns for 2 days in late November/ early December, inclusive of up to 3 nights full board and lodging in:

- a) Valtos and Laxay £1895 per gun
- b) Grimshader and Aline trees £1695 per gun

3 DAYS WALKED UP

WOODCOCK & HIND STALKING:

2 DRIVEN WOODCOCK DAYS

£2400 per person for a week by agreement in December or January for 6 guns, inclusive of walked up and driven woodcock shooting and stalking for up to 6 hinds, full board & lodging.

BOARD AND LODGING: Is charged per guest for those who do not wish to fish and/or shoot at £575 per week or £525 if 12 or more in the party. **Children:** Under 2 are free / 2 – 7: 25% of B & L rate / 8 - 12: 50% of B & L rate / 13 & above: full rate

V.A.T: All the above prices include VAT at 20%

Changeover: Incoming guests on Saturday may fish from 2pm onwards and then may fish the following Saturday until 1pm. On the day of your arrival please do not arrive at the Lodge before 2pm and kindly vacate by 11am the following Saturday.

Fish Return Policy: All salmon caught on the Laxay River to be returned. Guests may keep a cock salmon on Langavat. All sea trout are to be returned, brown trout may be kept. Rods may still fish and stalk if no grouse shooting is available in which event no shooting charge would be payable.

Deposit: A non returnable deposit of £2250 is payable to secure a booking. Cheques to be made payable to “SOVAL ESTATE” and sent to Richard Kershaw c/o Joseph Holt Ltd., The Brewery, Empire Street, Manchester M3 1JD or banking details available by emailing richard.kershaw@joseph-holt.com

Dogs: No dogs are allowed in the main part of the Lodge. Dogs may sleep in the entrance to the Lodge or in their owners cars.

Insurance: Guests are strongly advised to take out holiday insurance as in the event of them cancelling a booking, if the holiday cannot be re-let, the full charge will become due. Guests are required to have both fishing & shooting public liability (available through membership of a Trade body). Guests are advised to wear a life jacket at all times when fishing. It is a condition of our insurance guests must wear a life jacket when going out on the sea. Protective glasses must be worn by fishermen at all times. Anyone shooting or stalking is advised to wear protective glasses as well as ear protectors and Bismuth or steel cartridges must be used when shooting over water in Scotland.
